Art4Life is a small non-profit organization that gets no outside funding. A scholarship essentially means we write off some of your tuition. We try hard to help all of our families in need of assistance, but those who need more than we can offer are invited to apply with Adult and Family Services, as they will provide funds for full tuition if you qualify.

DEADLINE FOR SUMMER SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS ARE JUNE 4, 2022

- Partial scholarships are per week. Weekly payments are due the first day of each week your child will attend.
- Scholarships do not include field trip fees or swimming costs.
- Scholarships will be considered starting the date which they are received.
- Scholarships are not retroactive.
- Scholarships are never prorated, meaning the amount due is the same whether your child /children attend Art4Life summer camp every day of the week or only a few.
- Scholarships will NOT be considered unless the scholarship form is completely filled out and returned to us with a **\$50 application deposit**.
- Please include the Portland Public School free lunch letter with your application.
- You are responsible for fulfilling all payments based on the schedule submitted with this application.
- **No cancellations after the June 10 deadline.**
